Document Positioning
If you use documents regularly while you work you should think about the following aspects:

How do you tend to use hard copy?


- Do you read off hard copy a lot, eg reviewing printed reports or research?
- Do you annotate/make handwritten notes on hard copy?
- Do you cross reference hard copy whilst simultaneously using your display screen equipment?
- Do you work with the same documents for long periods or do you constantly flick between different documents?
- Do you copy type?

What is the nature of your document use?

- Do you work with hard copy intensively in long stretches?
- Do you use hard copy intermittently for short periods but regularly throughout the day?
- Do you use hard copy seldom for short periods?

Once you have thought about the way you use hard copy you will be able to decide about where to position it. The aim is to position your documents so that their use does not lead to awkward postures and minimises neck movement.

Placing hard copy flat on a desk leads to neck bending whilst reading and writing. This is reduced if you tilt the document up toward you.
